Minister:

May N be brought by grace
to the sacrament of baptism,
and come, with all your people,
to the fullness of your kingdom of love and peace;
through Jesus Christ our Lord.

BAPTISM - Confession of Faith & Responses

Confession of Faith

The Uniting Church, in baptising children, takes responsibility for their instruction and nourishment in the faith.

That we may know that you hold the Christian faith and claim your membership in Christ's Church, we ask you:

Minister: (addressing the parents)

Do you repent of your sins? I repent of my sins.

Do you turn to Jesus Christ who has defeated the power of sin and death and brought us new life?

I turn to Christ.

Do you commit yourself to God, trusting in Jesus Christ as Saviour and in the Holy Spirit as God's power and presence along the way? I commit myself to God.

Responses

N and N, I ask you now to respond to God's graciousness to N by making these solemn promises:

Will you encourage N's growth within the Christian community, guiding him/her through participation in the worship, nurture and fellowship of the Church to a mature Christian faith?

With God's help, we will.

Will you, by word and example, teach him/her the way of Christ until the Spirit draws him/her to make his/her own response in faith and love?
