Cutting Your Losses

This synonym is often used in business. For instance, an enterprising person takes on a new opportunity after a thorough evaluation. A business plan is drawn up, finance obtained and new prospective customers have been visited. Everything starts off on a good note. The first six months are positive and profitable. Then, for a number of reasons, including the loss of clientele, the business turns sour: customers have turned to competing businesses. The businessman knows he is going down a dead end road and he is advised to cut his losses and close the business.

Jesus told the story of the man who had one hundred sheep and loses one of them (Luke 15:1-4). Good asset management would be to take a careful count of the rest and provide better protection for them. You don't leave them to go off hunting for the lost one; it's a poor allocation of resources.

Jesus is not in the numbers game. Every single life is precious to Him. worthy of crazy searching that is not about management but about passion. As usual, Jesus turns conventional wisdom on its head. God's priorities are a radical reorientation of what we might expect. God prioritises you! Imagine! (Rev. Gordon)

A Message from the Elders

Last week we discussed how the Armour of God (Ephesians 6:10-20) enables us to make a stand against temptation. What happens if we are not fully armoured and we give in to temptation? What are the results of our sins? Take time, each day this week, to read and pray about the following in your alone time with God.

Read in Mark 7:1-23 where Jesus explains how sin defiles a person from within and how our self-made religious traditions can keep us from truly worshipping God with our hearts.

Read in John 8:31-47 where Jesus explains that sin enslaves us and keeps us from a loving relationship with God.

Read in Isaiah 59:1-21 how sin separates us from God. Read about God's judgement of sin and offer of redemption to those who acknowledge their sins and repent thereof.

Read in 1 Peter 2:11-25 how Jesus paid the full price for all our sins on the cross and how our sinful-selves died with Him. When He was raised, we were raised with Him to live new righteous lives in Christ.

Read in Romans 6:1-23 how we have become dead to sin, alive in Christ and slaves to righteousness; and no longer slaves to our sins!
