A Message from the Elders

What is discipleship? Is it the same as evangelism, or are they different things? How do evangelism and discipleship relate to one another. In Matthew 28:19 Jesus calls us to "go and make disciples of all nations..."

The men's Bible study groups recently had the opportunity to attend two parts of a four-part, web-based seminar series, hosted each Thursday night by panellists from Generate Presbytery and the Propel Network, made up by speakers from Uniting Churches across Australia.

The topics covered included evangelism, discipleship, leadership and church planting / renewal. The men's Bible study groups attended the sessions on evangelism and discipleship, and, after each session, the study groups met on-line and continued to discuss key points raised by the panellists in their own respective Bible study groups.

Members of the respective study groups remarked that they found the views expressed during these seminars, and the group discussions held afterwards, helpful in clarifying how evangelism and discipleship relate to each other and remarked that they had greater understanding of how these concepts should feature in the daily activities of every Christian.
