

A Message from the Elders

The past Thursday was Ascension Day, a day on which we commemorate the resurrected Jesus being taken up into heaven and being elevated to a position of ultimate authority over all of creation. There He remains until the appointed time comes for Him to return as Judge and Ruler over all peoples of the earth (Luke 24:44-53 and Acts 1:6-11). This day also marks Jesus' final appearance to His disciples following His resurrection.

Just before ascending to heaven, Jesus instructed the disciples to wait to receive empowerment from the Holy Spirit in order to become His faithful witnesses and to spread the Good News of the Gospel to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:8). This outpouring of the Holy Spirit is commemorated on Pentecost Sunday.
