MORE OCC NEWS FROM CORAL

Boxes collected in 2022 from South Australia / New Zealand amounted to 18,673. 288,104 were collected in Australia. The world total was 19,599,907.

Our state coordinator, Corinne Blom, met Pastor Francis from the Philippines at an OCC conference. He said that he was very encouraged by receiving the boxes from Australia. In addition, he was able to say that a huge number of children from the Philippines had enrolled in "The Greatest Journey". Across the world 2.4 million children had enrolled in this programme of 12 lessons and decided to follow Jesus. This meant approximately one child for each five children who received a box made this decision. What an amazing impact this has been on the lives of the children, their families, their communities and, ultimately, their nation. From the South Australian boxes this equates to 75 children per week!!! (Lynette Beck)
