My Ugandan Learning Experience

Visiting Uganda was rewarding in ways I didn't expect. I knew that it would be culturally very different and that I would be challenged in my thinking. But I was changed in ways I couldn't have anticipated.

I was warmed by the generous hospitality of the Ugandan people who had little in the way of material resources but had hearts that were lavish in their love for family, community and relationships and for the God in whom they trust implicitly. Their faith was tangible and lived out in day to day life in a way that is foreign to us, who have everything we need and an excess of it. It was foreign to me. We are taught here to be self-sufficient. I have learnt to be self-sufficient.

Self-sufficiency is anti-Gospel. Trusting God and leaning on Him rather than on our own understanding (or on our 'stuff' - Proverbs 3: 5,6) means not propping up ourselves. I have a great deal to learn here; I suspect that you might too.

I pray that as you hear about Uganda today you will hear much more about the God who loves Uganda and her people as He loves us: recklessly, lavishly and completely. You can trust Him!
