Be Moses

You actually have a "seat with [Christ] in the heavens" (Ephesians 2:6 NCV). You don't have a seat at the Supreme Court or in the House of Representatives. You have one far more strategic; you have a seat in the government of God. Like a congressman, you represent a district. You speak on behalf of your family, neighbourhood or softball team. Your sphere of influence is your region. As you grow in faith, your district expands. God burdens you with a concern for orphans, distant lands or needy people. You respond to these promptings by prayer. Fatherthey need help.

You are Moses in your cul-de-sac. Moses in your work force. Moses in your classroom. You plead with God on other people's behalf.

Intercessory prayer isn't rocket science. It acknowledges our inability and God's ability. We come with empty hands but high hopes. Why? 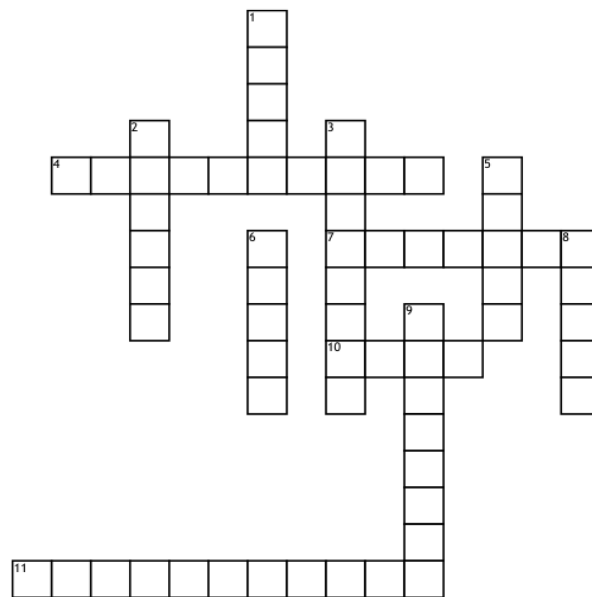
