Be Still

"Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!" Psalm 46:10

Jesus taught us to pray with reverence when he modelled for us "Hallowed be your name" (Matthew 6:9). This phrase is a petition, not a proclamation. A request, not an announcement. "Be hallowed, Lord." Do whatever it takes to be holy in my life. Take your rightful place on the throne. Exalt yourself. Magnify yourself. Glorify yourself. You be Lord, and I'll be quiet.

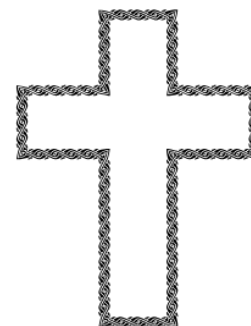
