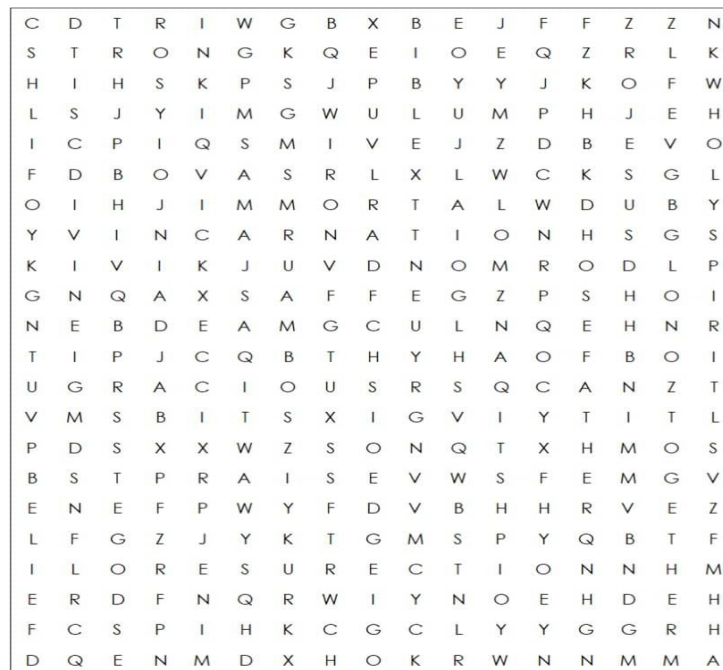

At Home with the Holy Trinity

God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are not like three stone statues sitting far away in heaven.

The Father loves His Son. He gives Him every good gift He has, and He delights in Him and praises Him (Matthew 3:17). The Son loves His Father (John 14:31). He freely and joyfully gives everything He has to the Father — even His own life (Hebrews 12:2). He delights to do the Father's will (Psalm 40:8) because He delights in the Father Himself.

The Holy Spirit also knows, loves, and shares life with the Father and the Son, just as they share life with one another (John 16:12-15). They are like family, and they joyfully share life together.

C.S. Lewis once said that when we are alone in our rooms and praying, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are all truly with us.
