Your Happiness Quota

'Be patient, bearing one another in love' Ephesians 4:2

Suppose a basket of ping pong balls represents your daily quota of happiness. Each aggravation, if you allow it, can snatch a ball out of your basket:

- He left his dirty clothes on the floor. A joy ball vanishes
- She waits until the last minute to apply her make up. Plop! There goes another one.
- Big trucks shouldn't take up two parking places!

There go the joy balls, one by one, until the joy is gone. How can you help people smile if you have a hole in your happiness basket? You can't. For this reason the apostle Paul said, "Be patient, bearing with one another in love." The apostle's word for **patient** is a term that combines "long" and "tempered". The patient person is "long tempered". The word **tempered** literally means "taking a long time to boil". In other words, not quickly overheated.

Irks come with life, but they need not diminish your life.
